## Bridge Construction over Westpark Drive/Gosnell Road at Route 7 to Cause Overnight Closings Starting Sunday, July 17

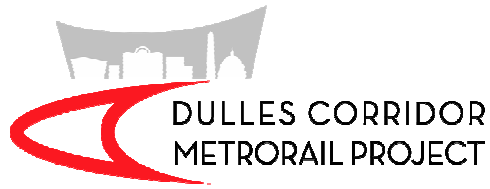
Drivers in Tysons Corner can expect overnight closings of part of the intersection of Route 7 (Leesburg Pike) and Westpark Drive/Gosnell Road beginning on or about Sunday, July 17 and continuing for up to six weeks.

Cranes will be used to start building bridge spans to carry future Dulles Corridor Metrorail tracks above that intersection whose landmarks include the Westpark Hotel, the Ernst and Young building and the former Business Bank building.

Thru traffic along both eastbound and westbound Leesburg Pike (Route 7) will be allowed. However, thru traffic on Westpark/Gosnell will not be allowed, and will be detoured using Route 7 as follows:

- Southbound Westpark Drive thru traffic can turn right on westbound Leesburg Pike, then U-turn at Spring Hill Road to turn right on Gosnell Road.
- Northbound Gosnell Road thru traffic can turn right on eastbound Leesburg Pike, pass under Route 123, turn left on International Drive, left on Chain Bridge Road (Route 123), then take the exit ramp to Route 7 to turn right on Westpark Drive.





Weather permitting, these closures will be in place from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sundays through Fridays for the next four to six weeks.

This work is taking place near where a large yellow and blue horizontal crane has been assembled in the median of Route 7. It will also will be used for bridge construction along Route 7 and had been used to build on rail bridges along the northwest side of Route 123 before being moved to the median of Route 7 several weeks ago.

Motorists are urged to use extreme caution, and pay attention to signage. All work is weather-dependent and subject to change.
