REMINDER: Full Closures of Eastbound Dulles Airport Access Highway and Toll Road Tonight, July 21 and Tomorrow Night

Drivers using the eastbound Dulles International Airport Access Highway and the Dulles Toll Road (Route 267) can expect delays near Route 7 overnight tonight, Thursday, July 21 and tomorrow night, July 22 because Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project crews will be building bridges to carry the rail line from the median of the Airport Access Highway to Route 7.

Full closures and detours are planned. Set-up will begin at approximately 7 p.m. and will be implemented as follows:

Eastbound Airport Highway Closure and Detour

- 7 p.m. – The left westbound lane will close near Route 7.
- 7:30 p.m. – The right eastbound lane will close near Route 7.
- 8 p.m. – All eastbound traffic will be diverted on to a single westbound lane, which will remain open to accommodate diverted Toll Road traffic (*see listing below*). At this time, westbound Airport Highway traffic will be two-way.
- Closures will be picked up in reverse order by 5 a.m. the following mornings.

Eastbound Dulles Toll Road (Route 267) Closure and Detour

The Airport Highway detour (*see details above*) will be combined with a closing and detour of the eastbound Dulles Toll Road, also near Route 7:

- 8 p.m. – The three left lanes of the eastbound Toll Road will close near Route 7.
- 10 p.m. – Eastbound toll road traffic will be switched on to the eastbound DIAAH.

Police will be onsite. Motorists are urged to use extreme caution, and pay attention to signage. All work is weather-dependent and subject to change.
