I-66 Westbound Detour Overnights May 23-24

Weather permitting, Interstate 66 westbound at the Dulles Connector Road (Route 267) will be closed overnight Monday, May 23 and Tuesday, May 24, between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m., for Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project construction.

These closures will affect drivers bound for destinations along I-66 west of Arlington.

Thru traffic will be detoured on to the Dulles Connector Road westbound, then on to the Capital Beltway north, to a U-turn at Georgetown Pike to go south on the beltway. Drivers can then rejoin I-66 from the beltway.

To avoid the closure, drivers bound for destinations inside the Capital Beltway may find alternate routes via other local westbound roads by exiting I-66 prior to the I-66/Dulles Connector Road split. For example, traffic bound for the Falls Church City/Broad Street and Idylwood areas can exit before the detour and use Route 29/Washington Street to connect with Broad Street (Route 7 west).

Police will be onsite for motorist safety.
