Dulles Rail Project Traffic Updates for Weekend of Jan. 20-22

Intersection of Tyco Road/Westwood Center Drive at Route 7 Closed Friday, Sunday Nights

Construction of the aerial guideway in the median of Leesburg Pike (Route 7) in Tysons Corner will continue Friday and Sunday nights, resulting in the closures of the middle of the Tyco Road/Westwood Center Drive intersection from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. both nights. This work will not occur on Saturday night.

Thru traffic along both directions of Route 7 will not be affected, but thru traffic on Tyco Road/Westwood Center Drive will not be permitted. Detour information is as follows:

- Southbound Tyco Road thru traffic **and** drivers wishing to turn left on to eastbound Route 7 will be directed to turn right on westbound Route 7, U-turn at Jarrett Valley Drive to access both eastbound Route 7 and Westwood Center Drive. *As a courtesy to the neighborhood, please do not use Jarrett Valley Drive or private property as a turnaround;*
- Northbound Westwood Center Drive thru traffic **and** drivers wishing to turn left on to westbound Route 7 will be directed to turn right on eastbound Route 7, U-turn at Spring Hill Road to access both westbound Route 7 and Tyco Road.

Note: The previously announced closures at the intersection of Westpark Drive/Gosnell Road and Route 7 have been cancelled.

Full Closure of Capital One Drive to Continue Saturday, Sunday Nights; Other Lane, Ramp Closures in the Area Planned

Capital One Drive, the main entrance to the Capital One complex along southbound Route 123, will be closed from 9 p.m. Friday, Jan. 20 through 5 a.m. Monday, Jan. 23. Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project construction crews will be lifting large concrete beams over the roadway to support the Tysons East station and bridge construction.

The turn lanes from northbound Route 123 into the Capital One Drive will be closed all weekend. To access the Capital One complex, traffic will be detoured by continuing on northbound Route 123, turning left on to Scotts Crossing Road, and then left into the alternate Capital One entrance.



The ***southbound lane*** of Route 123 also will be closed overnight Friday through Sunday from Scotts Crossing Road to the east side of I-495 to allow major deliveries to the station.

In addition, the entrance ramp from southbound Route 123 to northbound I-495 will be closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. on Friday and Sunday nights ***only***. On those nights, drivers can access northbound I-495, by continuing on southbound Route 123, turning right on International Drive, right on Galleria Drive, right on Tysons Boulevard, then right on to ***northbound*** Route 123, to the ***second*** right exit on to ***northbound*** I-495.

Police officers will be on site to control the intersection of Route 123 and Capital One Drive throughout the weekend.

All work is weather pending and subject to change. Should inclement weather delay the weekend's work, alternate overnight dates will be scheduled, and announced if necessary.
