Construction Activities Ramp Up Near Future Tysons East Metro Station

The Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project will begin preparations for construction of the future Tysons East Metrorail Station at the southwest corner of Route 123 (Dolley Madison Boulevard) and Scotts Crossing Road on or about the beginning of the week of Aug. 30.

Related preparation work for at-grade and aerial track work will also start next week along the north side of Route 123 from the Capital Beltway (I-495) on to the Dulles Connector Road (Route 267).

These activities are part of Phase 1 of the new Metrorail extension from the existing Orange Line to Wiehle Avenue in Reston.

Weather permitting, contractors are scheduled to begin clearing trees and brush in this area next week.

Foundation work on the station will follow later this year.

This work will take place Monday through Saturday. Occasional lane closures may be required as work progresses. Motorists should stay alert and be prepared for these construction activities.
