Pile Driving Activity to Begin at I-66 and Dulles Connector Road Interchange

Beginning Wednesday, July 22, weather permitting, the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project will begin pile driving activity along the Route 267 median between I-66 and the Idylwood Road Bridge. This activity, part of Phase 1 of the new Metrorail extension, drives steel piles into the soil to build foundations for track retaining walls and aerial track support structures.

The initial work in this area is expected to last approximately two months, and will be performed between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. In addition, general construction work will continue in this area in the coming months.
