Pile driving to begin in median of Dulles Airport Access Highway near W&OD Trail Bridge Crossover

Pile driving related to construction of the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project will begin Tuesday, Oct. 13, near where the Washington and Old Dominion (W&OD) Trail runs below the Dulles Toll Road and the Dulles International Airport Access Highway (the DIAAH).

This work, between Wiehle Avenue and Hunter Mill Road, is part of the construction a new bridge in the existing median of the Airport access road that carry the future rail line over the trail. Business located along Sunrise Valley, Robert Fulton, Alexander Bell and Preston White Drive will hear pile driving noise.

This process drives concrete piles into the soil to build foundations for aerial track support structures — such as the bridge being built over the W&OD Trail.

The work is expected to last approximately two weeks, and will be performed between 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. We would like you as an immediate neighbor to be aware of this construction activity.

All users of the trail should be watch for warning signs alerting shifts in the trail path, as well as equipment and materials in the adjacent slopes of the median.
