Lane Closures, Detour for Dulles Airport Access Highway, Aviation Drive and Toll Road for Aug 22-28

Weather permitting, the following lane and shoulder closures on the Dulles Airport Access Highway and the Dulles Toll are scheduled for the week of Aug. 22:

Dulles International Airport Access Highway (DIAAH) West Day and Night Work

When: Monday, Aug. 23 – Saturday, Aug. 28, 9:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
What: Left thru lane closed
Where: **Between mile markers 9.6 and 7.7**
Why: Retaining wall construction

When: Sunday, Aug. 22 – Tuesday, Aug. 24, 6:00 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.
What: Right lane closure
Where: **Between mile markers 6.0 (Wiehle Avenue overpass) and 5.5**
Why: Striping, barrier removal and relocation
Police: Onsite for motorist safety

When: Friday, August 27 – Sunday, Aug. 29, 24/7 beginning 9:30 p.m. Friday
What: Right thru lane closed
Where: **Between mile markers 6.2 and 5.8**
Why: Utility work
Police: Onsite for motorist safety

Dulles International Airport Access Highway (DIAAH) East Day and Night Work

When: Monday, August 23 – Friday, Aug. 27, 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
What: Left thru lane closed
Where: **Between mile markers 6.0 and 7.1**
Why: Retaining wall construction

When: Monday, Aug. 23 – Friday, Aug. 27, 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
What: Right thru lane closed
Where: **Between mile markers 7.8 and 8.4**
Why: Utility work



Dulles Toll Road (Route 267) West Day and Night Work

When: Sunday, Aug. 22, 7:00 a.m. to Monday, Aug. 23, 5:00 a.m.
What: Right lane closed
Where: **Between mile markers 5.9 (Wiehle Avenue overpass) and 6.0**
Why: Asphalt patching
Police: Onsite for motorist safety

When: Monday, Aug. 23 – Tuesday, Aug. 24, 9:30 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.
What: Left lane closed
Where: **Between mile markers 5.5 and 6.0**
Why: Barrier removal
Police: Onsite for motorist safety

When: Monday, Aug. 23 – Friday, Aug. 27, 9:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
What: Ramp narrowing and right lane closed
Where: **Between mile markers 6.2 (Wiehle Avenue ramp) and 5.5**
Why: Utility work

Dulles Toll Road (Route 267) East Day and Night Work

When: Sunday, Aug. 22, 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
What: Left lane closed
Where: **Between mile markers 5.9 (Wiehle Avenue overpass) and 6.0**
Why: Asphalt patching activity

When: Monday, Aug. 23 – Friday, Aug. 27, 10:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
What: Left thru lane closed
Where: **Between mile markers 7.8 and 8.4**
Why: Utility work

When: Monday, Aug. 23, 9:30 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.
What: Right thru lane closed
Where: **Between mile markers 6.9 and 7.5**
Why: Electrical work and barrier installation
Police: Onsite for motorist safety

When: Thursday, Aug. 26, midnight to 12:30 a.m.
What: Short duration road closure



Where: **At mile marker 11.4**
Why: Crane moves
Police: Onsite for motorist safety

Aviation Drive East Night Work

When: Tuesday, Aug. 24, 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
What: Alternating lane and road/ramp closures (***Detour when necessary: Right on ramp, then U-turn at the following median crossover***)
Where: **Between the off- and on-ramps from/to the DIAAH**
Why: Pavement repair and roadway markings
Police: Onsite for motorist safety

In addition, closures will continue in several sections of the service roads adjacent to east and westbound Leesburg Pike (Route 7); Leesburg Pike between Chain Bridge Road (Route 123) and the Dulles Toll Road. Access to all businesses will be maintained throughout the work periods. Also, lane closures on the Dulles International Airport Access Highway (DIAAH) and Dulles Toll Road should be expected.

Motorists should stay alert and be prepared to alter their travel along these roads.

The Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project is a 23-mile extension of Metro's existing Orange Line. The project is managed and owned by the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority.
