## **Overnight Detours of Eastbound Dulles Connector Road, Southbound Route 123 Scheduled Week of Oct. 24**

Construction of large, concrete aerial structures for the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project will cause overnight closures and detours at the Dulles Connector Road/Route 123 interchange.

Weather permitting, the following closures and detours will be in place from Sunday, Oct. 24 through Friday, Oct. 29, between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m. All roads will be open by the morning rush hour.

Here are the closings and detours involved:

- **Closed: The Eastbound Dulles Connector Road (Route 267 toward I-66/Washington)** between I-495 and Route 123 (Dolley Madison Boulevard) will be closed.  
**Detour: Traffic will be detoured Exit 18 to southbound I-495, to exit 46B to northbound Route 123 toward McLean, to right on-ramp to rejoin eastbound Route 267 toward I-66/Washington**
- **Southbound Dolley Madison Boulevard (Route 123)**  
**Closed:** South bound Route 123 between the two exit ramps from the Dulles Connector Road (Route 267)  
**Detour: Traffic from McLean, to left on Great Falls Street, right on [Old] Chain Bridge Road, right on Anderson Road to left southbound Route 123.**  
**Note:** The exit ramp from the westbound Dulles Connector Road to southbound Route 123 toward Tysons Corner also will be closed. Instead, exit to northbound Route 123 toward McLean, and then turn right on Great Falls Street to enter the detour.



Residents of this area may hear some noise from this work. Crews will make every effort to minimize noise between the hours of 11 p.m. and 7 a.m. Because this work is extremely dangerous, there will be noise, including safety back-up beepers that have been modified for nighttime work.

*The Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project is a 23-mile extension of Metro's existing Orange Line. The project is managed and owned by the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority. The design-build construction contractor is Dulles Transit Partners.
