Construction over Spring Hill Road/Route 7 Intersection Continues; Lane Closures on Southbound I-495, Route 123 Tonight, Dec. 20

Overnight closures of north and southbound Spring Hill Road at Route 7 in Tysons will continue tonight, Tuesday, Dec. 20, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. due to Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project bridge construction over that intersection. Please note the detours below:

- Southbound Spring Hill Road thru traffic **and** motorists wanting to turn left on to eastbound Leesburg Pike will need to turn right on to westbound Leesburg Pike, then U-turn at Tyco Road/Westwood Center Drive, and continue on eastbound Leesburg Pike toward Spring Hill Road.
- Northbound Spring Hill Road thru traffic **and** motorists wanting to turn left on to westbound Leesburg Pike will need to turn right on to eastbound Leesburg Pike, U-turn at Westpark Drive/Gosnell Road, and continue on westbound Route 7 to access Spring Hill Road.

Southbound I-495 Lane Closures

The **three left lanes** of **southbound** I-495 will be closed from Lewinsville Road to Route 123 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. tonight. Thru traffic still will be allowed, but motorists should expect some delays.

Southbound Route 123 Lane/Ramp Closures

The **right lane** of southbound Route 123 will be closed from Capital One Drive to the ramp to northbound I-495 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. The **ramp** from southbound Route 123 to northbound I-495 also will be closed tonight during those hours. Traffic will be instructed to continue on southbound Route 123, turn right on International Drive, right on Galleria Drive, right on Tysons Boulevard, then a slight left on to northbound Route 123 to northbound I-495.

Police will be on site during all closures. Motorists are urged to use extreme caution, and pay attention to signage. All work is weather-dependent and subject to change.
